**Scripture:** Luke 12:49-59 ("Not Peace, but Confrontation as we interpret our times" – a blended translation)

Jesus said, I came to ignite the earth, and would that it were already kindled and blazing! I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how great is my distress until it is accomplished! Do you think that I have come to give peace and complacency on earth? I want to turn every thing right-side-up! And I want it finished. Do you think I came to smooth things over and make every thing nice? No, I came to disrupt and confront! For from now on in one house there will be five divided, three against two and two against three. They will be divided, father against son and son against father – mother against daughter and daughter in-law against mother-in-law.

Jesus also said to the crowds, "When you see a cloud rising in the west, you say, 'A storm is coming.' And when the wind comes out of the south, you say, 'This'll be a hot one!' - and your right. Frauds and pretenders! You know how to interpret the appearances of earth and sky in the weather, so don't tell me you can't interpret the events of the present day?"

"You don't have to be a genius to understand these things. Just use you common sense, the kind you would use if an accuser were taking you to court, you would decide to settle up with your adversary on the way to trial, knowing that when you go before the judge you'd probably go to jail and pay a heavy fine. That's the kind of decision I'm asking you to make."
