#### Guest Preacher's Bio:

Jonathan Roach is an ordained UCC pastor, theologian, author, and librarian. He grewup across the Midwest in Terre Haute, Indiana, the twin cities of Dennison and Uhrichsville, Ohio, and Alpena, Michigan, which is literally halfway between the equator and the North Pole. After earning his BA in English Education, he earned graduate degrees from Wayne State University (MLIS), Ecumenical Theological Seminary (MDiv), and St. Thomas University (PhD). He was ordained in 2008 at his home church, First Congregational Church of Detroit, Michigan. For his Ph.D. in practical theology, he worked with a group of United Church of Christ clergy to develop a theology of work for clergy who had suffered burnout. He has over 40 publications including his first book "Expressing Theology: A Guide to Writing Theology that Readers Want to Read" in 2015, and he served on the faculty of Ecumenical Theological Seminary from 2002-2009. He left St. Thomas University where he was Interim-Dean of the Library when he was called to the role of pastor and teacher of Stratham Community Church, United Church of Christ in New Hampshire. In July of 2019, he moved with his family to Hilo, Hawai'i when his wife, Rev. Jihey Roach, accepted the call to serve Hawai'i Care Choices and is looking forward to what comes next!
